The Conference will take place at the AXIS OFIR Beach Resort Hotel (4-star Hotel), ideally located directly on a long sandy beach, with a protected landscape and surrounding the mouth of the river Cávado, and in a wonderful historic and cultural region with the uninterrupted tradition from the early ages, with three locations/zones proclaimed the UNESCO cultural World Heritage within 100 km: Historic Centre of Guimarães, Historic Centre of Porto and Alto Douro Wine Region.
